

Japan Bank of International Co-operation (JBIC)

Japan is providing ODA (Official Development Assistance) loan to developing countries at low rates of interest and with long repayment periods to develop and improve the economic and social infrastructure for sustainable economic development. JBIC's Overseas Economic Cooperation Operations are in charge of the major part of ODA loans. So far 3 Major Projects namely Upper Indravati Irrigation Project (RD 15.00 to 52.00 Km.), Upper Kolab irrigation Project (RD14.00 to 41.78 Km) & Rengali Left Bank Canal (RD 29.177 to 71.313 km.) have been sanctioned under this scheme.

Scheme Status

Out of three sanctioned projects, two projects namely Upper Indravati and Upper Kolab have been completed. At present, Rengali Left Bank Canal (RD 29.177 to 71.313 Km.) is under progress since 1997. The project is scheduled for completion by June 2011. The physical and financial progress is given in the following table.
